Med/Vet/Dental Application Newsletter MCAT Updates: Registration, Prep Resources, & Fee Assistance 2025-2026 January 2025

If you are planning to take the MCAT in the Spring or Summer, please note that registration for the second half of the 2025 testing year (July – September) will open on Wednesday, February 19th at 12:00 PM EST. Your registration opening date is based on your test center location (see more information below about testing sites).

Testing dates fill up very quickly, so if you already know when you want to take the MCAT, make sure to sign up as soon as registration opens. Please see the <u>AAMC's Tips</u> for Registration Day to prepare for the sign up process.

Be sure to read this newsletter carefully for **essential information** about signing up for the MCAT, as well as information about preparation in general. **Please read our** <u>MCAT Tips</u> **and** <u>MCAT Prep Resources</u> for further information. Even if you plan to take the MCAT in a future year, this information may still be helpful for you.

Reminder: Sign up for the MedApp2025-2026 Listserv!

If you have not already, **please make sure to sign up for the MedApp2025-2026 listserv** (see link to the sign-up form below) if you plan, or are seriously considering, applying to the 2025-2026 Med/Vet/Dental application cycle. As we get further into the cycle, we will use this listserv exclusively to convey crucial information about the application, so it is to your benefit to sign up for the listserv so you can receive these communications.

Note: If you are a current senior, when filling out the sign-up form it will be beneficial to you to also enter a non-Dartmouth email so you can continue to receive communications after you graduate, and your Dartmouth email becomes deactivated.

MCAT Registration: Test Dates & Calendar

- For July September testing dates, registration opens on February 19th at 12:00 PM EST.
- **IMPORTANT!** Testing dates do fill quickly, so if you already know when you want to take the MCAT, make sure to sign up as soon as registration opens. Research ahead of time to know the locations nearest to Dartmouth (see Nearest Testing Sites section below for more info) or your home.
- See the <u>AAMC-MCAT website</u> for information about the content of the MCAT, how to register, and resources for preparation; as well as financing the MCAT. You can also learn about <u>MCAT prep resources</u>.
- <u>DO Sign up HERE to receive email updates</u> from the AAMC about MCAT updates and important logistical information.
- <u>GO HERE to learn all about registering for the exam</u> itself ahead of time. Don't wait until the sign-up day opens. Understand the process, location of testing centers, etc.
- <u>Create YOUR AAMC account HERE now!</u> You can do this already. Then you'll be all set if you are planning to register this October for January and March June dates. That account will be your AAMC account for everything including your future application, and beyond!

Nearest Testing Sites

Planning will be required to travel to your testing sites and may require leaving the day before to be at the site on time on test day.

- The closest testing site to Dartmouth is in Concord, NH which is about an hour away.
- The next closest testing site is in Burlington, VT which is about an hour and a half away.

• There are several sites in Massachusetts including three in Boston, several in surrounding areas, and 1 in Springfield, MA.

Preparation Resources

It is essential to make a plan that is appropriate to YOU. When will you be best prepared to take the MCAT? When will you have time to commit to studying for the MCAT?

- The <u>HPP website</u> also has information and links to resources to prepare for the MCAT.
- Memm and Anki are two MCAT study tools students have used.

The Financial Assistance Program (FAP)

The AAMC does have a **Fee Assistance Program (FAP)** to help defray the cost of the MCAT and AMCAS application.

- **IMPORTANT NOTE!** To access the benefits, you must be approved before you register for the MCAT exam or apply to medical schools using the AMCAS application. Benefits are not retroactive. The application process can take up to 5-10 business days to be approved, so keep that in mind as you <u>prepare to apply</u>. There is a lot of <u>information to gather in order to apply</u>, so we recommend starting this process at least a few weeks in advance.
- If you qualify for the FAP you also receive it for the AMCAS application (within a certain timeframe).
- If you miss the FAP eligibility by a tiny fraction, it can't hurt to contact the FAP Office directly.
- If you do sign up for the MCAT before getting approved, you can still apply to get approved for the actual application process.
